In the Lecture Room, Albert Hall on Thursday, April 14

As part of the Canberra and Region Heritage Festival, a panel of experts will uncover the intended original design of the Albert Hall, show what was achieved, and reveal their discoveries about its original interior design and external features during the conservation process. They will also provide an update on progress on the conservation of Albert Hall.

- Phillip Leeson, heritage consultant on the replacement of the Albert Hall curtains
- Dr Lenore Coltheart, historian and adviser on refurbishment

The event will include a guided tour of Albert Hall, and refreshments.
